



All facilities used to store and process Data will adhere to reasonable security standards no less protective than the security standards at facilities where **SLSPL** stores and processes its own information of a similar type. 2. Modifications to the Services

3. End User Consent

5. Availability and Uptime

7. Termination for Breach

- 7.1. Either party may suspend performance or terminate this Agreement if:
 - 7.1.1. the other party is in material breach of the Agreement and fails to cure that breach within 30 (thirty days) after receipt of written notice;
 - 7.1.2. the other party ceases its business operations or becomes subject to insolvency proceedings and the proceedings are not dismissed within 90 (ninety days); or
 - 7.1.3. the other party is in material breach of this Agreement more than two times notwithstanding any cure of such breaches.
- 7.2. **College** may terminate this Agreement for any reason (or no reason) with 60 (sixty days) prior written notice to **SLSPL**, provided, however, that **College** will remain obligated to pay any Fees for Services which **College** has purchased applicable to the remainder of the then current Services Term for those Services.

8. Exceptions of Termination

- 8:1. For the avoidance of doubt, downtime caused directly or indirectly by any of the following shall not be considered a breach of this Agreement:
 - 8.1.1. à Force Majeure Évent;
 - 8.1.2. a fault or failure of the internet or any public telecommunications network;
 - 8.1.3. a fault or failure of the College's computer systems or networks;
 - 8.1.4. any breach by the College of this Agreement; or
 - 8.1.5. scheduled maintenance carried out in accordance with this Agreement.

9. Warranties

- 9.1. The SLSPL warrants to the College that:
 - 9.1.1. the Provider has the legal right and authority to enter into this Agreement and to perform its obligations under this Agreement
 - 9.1.2 the Provider will comply with all applicable legal and regulatory requirements applying to the exercise of the Provider's rights and the fulfilment of the Provider's obligations under this Agreement and
 - 9.1.3. the Provider has or has access to all necessary know-how, expertise and experience to perform its obligations under this Agreement.
- 9.2. The College warrants to SLSPL that:
 - 9.2.1. the Platform and Hosted Services will conform in all material respects with the Hosted Services Specification
 - 9.2.2. the Hosted Services will be free from Hosted Services Defects

- 9.2.3. the Platform will be free from viruses, worms, Trojan horses, ransomware, spyware, adware and other malicious software programs and

10. Force Majeure

10.1. Either Party shall be excused from any delay or failure in performance required hereunder if caused by reason of any occurrence or contingency beyond its reasonable control, including, but not limited to, acts of God, acts of war, fire, insurrection, strikes, lock-outs or other serious labour disputes, riots, earthquakes, floods, explosions or other acts of nature. The obligations and rights of the Party so excused shall be extended on a day-to-day basis for the time period equal to the period of such excusable interruption. When such events have abated, the Parties' respective obligations hereunder shall resume. In the event the interruption of the excused Party's obligations continues for a period in excess of ninety (90) calendar days, either Party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) calendar days' prior written notice to the other Party.

11. No Agency

11:1. The parties are independent contractors, and this Agreement does not create an agency, partnership or joint venture.

12. Amendments

12.1. Any amendment must be in writing and expressly state that it is amending this Agreement.

13. SISPL's confidentiality obligations.

13.1. The provider must

- 13.1.1, keep the College Confidential Information strictly confidential;
- 13.1.2. not disclose the College Confidential Information to any person without the College's prior written consent and then only under conditions of confidentiality approved in writing by the College OR no less onerous than those contained in this Agreement
- 13.1.3. use the same degree of care to protect the confidentiality of the College Confidential Information as the Provider uses to protect the Provider's own confidential information of a similar nature, being at least a reasonable degree of care;
- 13.1.4. act in good faith at all times in relation to the College Confidential Information and
- 13.1.5. not use any of the College Confidential Information for any purpose other than the specific purpose.
- 13.1.6. Not sell or disclose the college's data to any third party
- 13.2. the Provider may disclose the **College** Confidential Information to the Provider's officers, employees, professional advisers, insurers, agents and subcontractors who have a need to access the **College** Confidential Information for

the performance of their work with respect to this Agreement and who are bound by a written agreement or professional obligation to protect the confidentiality of the **College** Confidential Information.

- 13.3. This Clause 13 imposes no obligations upon the Provider with respect to **College** Confidential Information that:
 - 13.3.1. is known to the Provider before disclosure under this Agreement and is not subject to any other obligation of confidentiality;
 - 13.3.2. is or becomes publicly known through no act or default of the Provider; or

- 13.4. The restrictions in this Clause 13 do not apply to the extent that any **College** Confidential Information is required to be disclosed by any law or regulation, by any judicial or governmental order or request, or pursuant to disclosure requirements relating to the listing of the stock of the Provider on any recognised stock exchange.
- 13.5. The provisions of this Clause 13 shall continue in force indefinitely following the termination of this Agreement OR for a period of six months following the termination of this Agreement, at the end of which period they will cease to have effect:
- 14. Exclusivity **SLSPL** will exclusively provide and maintain a branded job board for the **college** and its end users for minimum period of two years. The **college** gives us explicit rights to use the **college**/school/university's brand for the said purpose of creating a job board for its students and in good faith.

15. Scheduled maintenance

College also grants to the Provider the right to sub-license these rights to its hosting, connectivity and telecommunications service providers, subject to any express, restrictions elsewhere in this Agreement.

- 16.2. The **College** warrants to the Provider that the **College** Data OR the **College** Data when used by the Provider in accordance with this Agreement will not infringe the Intellectual Property Rights or other legal rights of any person and will not breach the provisions of any law, statute or regulation, in any jurisdiction and under any applicable law.
- 16.3. The Provider can delete **college** data when the service is completed, contract is terminated, or in any other situation deemed reasonable by the provider

17. No assignment of Intellectual Property Rights

17.1. Nothing in this Agreement shall operate to assign or transfer any Intellectual Property Rights from the Provider to the College, or from the College to the Provider.

18. Data protection

- 18.1. The Provider OR Each party shall comply with the Data Protection Laws, with respect to the processing of the College Personal Data.
- 18.2. The **College** warrants to the Provider that it has the legal right to disclose all Personal Data that it does in fact disclose to the Provider under or in connection with this Agreement.
- 18.3. The **College** shall only supply to the Provider, and the Provider shall only process, in each case under or in relation to this Agreement
- 18.4. The **College** hereby authorises the Provider to make the following transfers of **College** Personal Data:
 - 18.4.1. the Provider may transfer the **College** Personal Data internally to its own employees, offices and facilities in *jurisdiction(s)*, providing that such transfers must be protected by appropriate safeguard.
 - the Provider may transfer the **College** Personal Data to its third party processors in the jurisdictions identified in this agreement such as internet service providers, hosting servers, telecommunications towers, etc (Data processing information) and may permit its third party processors to make such transfers, providing that such transfers must be protected by any appropriate safeguards identified therein; and
- 18.5. The Provider shall ensure that persons authorised to process the **College** Personal Data have committed themselves to confidentiality or are under an appropriate statutory obligation of confidentiality.

- 18.6. The Provider shall, insofar as possible and taking into account the nature of the processing, take appropriate technical and organisational measures to assist the College with the fulfilment of the College's obligation to respond to requests exercising a data subject's rights under the Data Protection Laws:

Both Parties shall indemnify and hold harmless the other from and against all direct losses, costs, actions, suits, damages, liabilities, fines, penalties of any kind or nature, third party claims whatsoever resulting from or relating to the misrepresentation, breach of any of the terms of this agreement, negligence, default, unauthorized act or omission/commission on the part of such Party

20. Jurisdiction

20.1. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. The adjudication of any dispute will be the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Mumbai

21. Miscellaneous

- 21.1. SLSPL does not guarantee or make an offer of any employment
- 21.2. SLSPL provides the platform for networking purposes
- 21.3. **Employers** can accept invites of **colleges** who have profiles on the platform

This MoU is effective from 13/12/ 2021, hereinafter mentioned as "Effective Date" by and between BL Amlani College of Commerce and Economics, managed under the Matushri Kanbai Lalbai & Motibal Lohana Kanyashala & Balikagruh Trust affiliated to the University of Mumbai, Maharashtra, registered under The Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950 (if applicable) and hereinafter referred to as "The College", having PAN AAATM4699P, represented by its Principal, Dr. Jitendra Aherkar.

AND

TNS India Foundation, a charitable organization registered under section 25 of the Companies Act 1956 and having its registered office at 81-201, Centre Point, Opposite Bawla MasJid, 243A, N M Joshi Marg, Lower Parel (E), Mumbai-400 013, hereinafter referred as "TNSIF" having PAN AAECT4021D, represented by its Senior Practice Leader, Rupa Bohra.

Background

TNS India Foundation (TNSiF), a section 25 Company incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956 is conducting the "Campus to Corporate Careers (C2C) Program" for the enhancement of employability and workplace skills for deserving youth.

In this connection, TNSIF intends to be associated and work closely with the College to conduct employability training, career counselling sessions and job placements for final year college students.

Detailed features of the program are as follows:

- 1. 80 100 hours of training program including Personal and Professional Effectiveness (how to choose right career option, how to apply for job, tools-CVs, cover letter- etc.), Business communication (effective communication with co-workers and customers), Career Readiness (orienting students to jobs matching their skill sets and exposure to a career path) and Work Readiness (Professionalism, Work Ethics, Email Etiquettes, Workplace dynamics etc.)
- 2. The training will be delivered via a blended learning approach i.e through in class sessions and online platforms (Google Meet and Zoom) as applicable.
- 3. Sessions of duration 3 hours duration will be conducted 5 days a week.
- 4. The program also includes individual student counselling, which will be conducted via online/offline platforms, as well as post training, pre-placement and post placement counselling.
- 5. Career fairs or individual placement drives will be conducted in an online/offline format to place trained students in formal sector jobs.
- The above mentioned training and placement is free of cost for both, the students and college.



Based on the above, this MOU lays out the below responsibilities for both parties:

TNStF agrees to -

- Engage with the college, given the following conditions:
 - a. In consultation and agreement with the designated college point of contact.
 - b. Not charge the college or students for any part of the program.
 - Provide reports to the college on the training and placement status of students.
- Mobilize the college students. This involves the following:
 - a. Conduct Orientation sessions to make students aware about the program and to register their interest.
 - b. Screen the students based on their interest and background and interview them to determine enrolment in the program.
- 3. Train selected students. This involves the following:
 - a. Form batches with selected students and conduct the Campus to Corporate Careers Training Program with them.
 - Provide individual career-counselling support to in-training students.
 - c. Engage with parents of the students to make them aware of the program and to counsel them about their wards.
 - d. Provide certificates to trained students on successful completion of the training with an attendance criteria of 80%.
- Place trained students. This involves the following:
 - a. Facilitate placement linkages with formal sector employers for interested students.
 - b. Arrange for career drives and fairs to place interested students.
 - Provide post-placement support to students to facilitate joining and on-boarding.

The College agrees to -

- Engage with TNSIF staff, given the following conditions:
 - a. Providing one point of contact to coordinate all TMSIF-C2C activities.
 - b. Not charge TNSIF or students for any part of the program.
 - c. Communicate openly with the TNSIF point of contact for any deliverables or feedback.
 - Facilitate student engagement. This involves the following:
 - Assistance in student mobilization through dissemination of information on student what's app groups and other seminars.
 - b. Attending orientation sessions organized by TNSIF to encourage student participation.
 - 3. Support training activities. This involves the following:
 - Support allocation of batches for optimum utilization of resources and training effectiveness.
 - Assist in scheduling batches keeping in mind college lecture timings.
 - Make classrooms available for in-person training sessions.
 - d. Allow use of online medium to reach and train students.
 - e. Assist in conducting parent engagement sessions.
 - Support placement activities. This involves the following:
 - a. Assist in mobilizing students to counsel regarding placement opportunities
 - b. Provide infrastructure assistance classrooms, auditorium, computer laboratory etc. in conducting on-ground career fests.
 - Allow use of online medium to place students.
 - d. Not hold TNSIF C2C staff responsible for any miscommunication with the corporate HRs.





This MOU is neither a contract nor is it legally binding in any way. It does not commit any financial expenditure from or for either party.

The MoU will be effective for a period of one year from the date on which both the parties have signed this MOU.
